- both acute and delayed
 Eyes: An eye contact with cement (dry or wet) may cause serious eye damage potentially irreversible.
 Skin: Cement may have an irritating effect on wet skin (through perspiration or ambient humidity) after prolonged contact, or may cause allergic reaction (eczematous dermatitis) after repeated contact.
 A prolonged skin contact with wet cement or wet mortar/concrete may cause severe burns because they occur without the person experiencing pain (this can occur e.g. by kneeling in the concrete, even through the pants).
- Inhalation: Repeated inhalation of cement dust over a long period increases the risk of developing lung diseases.
